



On-site exams: information for students

What happens in case of an on-site exam when you...

...receive a positive SARS-CoV-2 / COVID-19 test result and are able to submit medical documents

procedure: If you have a positive SARS-CoV-2 / COVID-19 test result, then you are not allowed to participate in the on-site exams and are not authorised to appear at the Irchel Campus within the ordered isolation time. Please, upload your medical documents via the [student portal](#).

classification: «ill with letter of excuse»

consequences: End of July, you will receive an application form for the repeat examination.
(repetition term: first attempt)

...have SARS-CoV-2 / COVID-19 symptoms, but possess not (yet) any medical test result

procedure: If you feel ill, then you are not allowed to participate in the on-site exams and are not authorised to appear at the Irchel Campus within the ordered isolation time. Please, upload your medical certificate via the [student portal](#).

classification: «ill with letter of excuse»

consequences: End of July, you will receive an application form for the repeat examination.
(repetition term: first attempt)

...have SARS-CoV-2 / COVID-19 symptoms, but a negative SARS-CoV-2 / COVID-19 medical test result

procedure: If you feel ill, then you are not allowed to participate in the on-site exams and are not authorised to appear at the Irchel Campus during your illness. Please, upload a medical certificate via the [student portal](#).

classification: «ill with letter of excuse»

consequences: End of July, you will receive an application form for the repeat examination.
(repetition term: first attempt)

...have received a governmental ordered quarantine obligation

procedure: If you are in quarantine during the examination, then you are not allowed to participate in the on-site exams and are not authorised to appear at the Irchel Campus within the ordered isolation time. Please, notify and upload your documents via the [student portal](#).

classification: «ill with letter of excuse»

consequences: End of July, you will receive an application form for the repeat examination.
(repetition term: first attempt)



...go in self-isolation without any governmental ordered quarantine

procedure: If you are in self-quarantine during exams, then you are not allowed to participate in the on-site exams and are not authorised to appear at the Irchel Campus. You should report your case via the [student portal](#).

classification: «ill»

consequences: End of July, you will receive an application form for the repeat examination. (each single case will be checked by the dean's office)

...return from a country or area with high risk of coronavirus infection with inflicted quarantine by the Federal Office of Public Health Switzerland

procedure: If you are in quarantine during an examination, then you are not allowed to participate in the on-site exams and are not authorised to appear at the Irchel Campus.

classification: If the country or area was listed on the Federal Office Of Public Health website before your outward journey, then the exam counts as failed. This is personal responsibility.

consequences: End of July, there will be the possibility for the application for the repeat examination. (repetition term: second attempt)

...are a person at especially high risk

procedure: You should already have informed the dean's office, because the Office of Student Affairs needs in any case documents and a preliminary lead time. The application period is expired. At this juncture, you should hand in a medical certificate and explain the actual situation via the [student portal](#).

classification: Dependent on the circumstances of the case the dean's office decides if it counts as "ill".

consequences: Possibly, you can write the exam in a special room together with the students with compensation adaptations. The dean's office will decide if there will be an application for the repeat examination and when the examination will take place.

...have to serve in the army at short-term

procedure: You should contact Beat Peter (beat.peter@mnf.uzh.ch) before the exam and keep all important documents at hand.

consequences: You can choose a) cancellation of the module, or b) postpone the exam until the repeat examination term.
