Information for students for the exams of the spring semester 2021

- There is a general obligation to wear a mask on the entire Irchel campus, even for persons who have been vaccinated or tested negative. The mask must also be worn during the examinations. If you are exempt from the mask wearing obligation, please take the confirmation with you to the exam.
- There are stations with hand disinfectant and containers with disinfectant wipes in front of the lecture halls. You must disinfect your workplace yourself with the wipes.
- If you feel ill or have a fever, even independently of Covid-19, do not come to the exam. Submit a doctor's note via the student portal within 5 working days.
- If you are in quarantine on the exam date, please also report this via the student portal.
- If your exam is being held in more than one room at the same time, you should be informed about your exam room prior to the exam.
- Arrive on campus approximately 20 minutes before the exam begins. Maintain a safe distance while waiting in line. We ask that you leave the inside area of the campus immediately after your last exam.
- Adhere to the safety guidelines during breaks between exams. Note that there is limited seating in the cafeterias and the mensa. If necessary, bring something to eat and drink from home.
- Since May 10, there is a Corona test station on the Irchel campus near the lecturers' foyer. The test is free of charge. You will need to show your health insurance card. You can find the link to book an appointment on www.uzh.ch/cmsssl/de/about/coronavirus.html in the upper right corner.
- We recommend that all students to install the Covid-19 app so that contact tracing is possible.
